

# ONE EIGHT – YEAR 1

## 2016 – 2017 Syllabus

ONE EIGHT is a two year comprehensive Catholic model of preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. The name, ONE EIGHT, comes from Acts 1:8, “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” These were the last words Jesus spoke to His disciples to prepare them to receive the Holy Spirit at Pentecost and these are the words Jesus speaks to the candidates as they prepare to receive a fuller out-pouring of the Holy Spirit at their Pentecost, Confirmation.

One week each month will be designated for Year 1 candidates, and one week will be designated for the Year 2 candidates.
