

Dear Parents,

As pastor of Good Shepherd Catholic Church, I want to congratulate you on this happy occasion of preparing for your child to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.

There are specific requirements for parents and Godparents determined by Holy Mother Church and adhered to by the Catholic Diocese of Sacramento that must be completed prior to your child receiving the Sacrament of Baptism. The Good Shepherd Parish office staff has developed the information in this letter, as well as the "Godparents' Information Sheet" to assist you in completing these requirements. Please know that we are committed to helping you at this important time in your child's Catholic faith formation and sacramental life.

For **<u>parents</u>** requesting the Sacrament of Baptism for their child at Good Shepherd Church, the following are required:

- Registered in Good Shepherd Parish
- Attending Sunday Mass
- Practicing the faith
- Completing the enclosed "Baptismal Information" form for permanent church records
- Attending a Baptism preparation class
  - Due to Covid restrictions, our baptism class is offered online through Agape Ministries.
  - The exception to attending this class is if the parents can provide proof of having attended a Sacrament of Baptism Preparation class within the last two years.

Regarding <u>Godparents</u>, at least one must meet the Diocesan regulation of being Catholic, meaning he/she has received the Sacraments of initiation (including Confirmation), married in the church (if applicable), attends church regularly, and is at least 16 years of age. Please refer to the "Godparents' Information Sheet" for more details on what Godparents are expected to complete prior to the Baptism date.

Baptisms are held monthly at Good Shepherd Church on the second and fourth Saturday at 10:00 am. No Baptisms are scheduled during the season of Lent. <u>Your child's Baptism will be scheduled once you have completed the preparation class</u>. To avoid any misunderstandings, **we recommend** that no arrangements be made for the date of the Baptism until the class requirement is completed.

If at any time a need to change the date occurs, please know that the staff will work with you to reschedule the best possible day for your child's Baptism.

Couples often wish to donate a "love offering" to the parish in gratitude for all that the volunteers in the Baptism Ministry do to assure each child and family have a spiritually beautiful experience. Should you desire to make such an offering you will have the opportunity to do so the day of the Baptism.

Lastly, we ask that on the Saturday morning of the scheduled Baptism that you, the child, and the Godparents arrive inside Good Shepherd Church no later than 9:40 am. This allows time for you to check in with the Baptism Coordinator and get settled in order to help the ceremony start promptly at 10:00.

The Sacrament of Baptism initiates your child into the Faith Community of Good Shepherd Parish. On behalf of myself, Father Julius Kaburu, Deacon Rommel Declines, Deacon Al Llenos, Deacon Bill Souza, and the parish office staff, I welcome you and invite you to worship with us as a family on a regular basis. We encourage all families to get involved in the spiritual life of the parish.

If there is any special circumstance you may have surrounding your child's Baptism, or questions not answered in this letter or enclosed material, please contact the parish office so we can assist you at this cherished time in the life of your child and your family.
