Category 1: Service (front facing – meaning, dealing with people you are “serving” face-to-face) done supporting Ministries and Non-Profit Organizations that address Corporal Works of Mercy and Catholic Social Justice Issues. See the ON MISSION: Christian Service Resources guide in your Google Classroom for ideas, ministries and non-profit organizations.

If you come up with service that you think would fall under this category but is not already on the list, you **MUST** get prior authorization from Mrs. Pott or you run the risk of your service not being counted towards fulfilling your requirement.

There is **NO limit** to the number of service hours you can submit in **Category 1**.

Category 2: Liturgical ministry service. This would include Altar Serving, being a Family Mass Greeter, participating in one of the Mass Choirs, assisting with CLOW, Kinderchurch, or CFF instruction/classes.

Service during Mass:

- Altar Serving: 1 Mass = 1 hour of service
- Choir: 1 Mass = 1 hour of service
- Family Mass Greeter: 1 Mass = 1 hour of service

If you come up with service that you think would fall under this category but is not already on the list, you **MUST** get prior authorization from Mrs. Pott or you run the risk of your service not being counted towards fulfilling your requirement.

You are limited to a **maximum of 8 hours** of service that you can submit in **Category 2**.

Category 3: Service is done setting up or cleaning up a Parish or St. Elizabeth Ann Seton event. This is service that is a “support” capacity for an event. It is necessary service for these events, but does not allow you to interact with the faith community at large.

If you come up with service that you think would fall under this category but is not already on the list, you **MUST** get prior authorization from Mrs. Pott or you run the risk of your service not being counted towards fulfilling your requirement.

You are limited to a **maximum of 5 hours** of service that you can submit in **Category 3**.

Category 4: We want to encourage teens and their families to go out in the greater community and support fundraising “walks” for worthwhile non-profit organizations in our area.

If you find a fundraising walk that you think would fall under this category but is not already on the list, you **MUST** get prior authorization from Mrs. Pott or you run the risk of your service not being counted towards fulfilling your requirement.

You are limited to **1 fundraising walk** per year within **Category 4**.

- There is a maximum of 2 service hours for participating in a fundraising walk.
- If you can show proof that you made at least a \$50 donation to the organization in addition to your registration fee, we will credit you 1 additional service hour.
