Liturgy of the Word

- This weekend, we celebrate the Anniversary of the Dedication of the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament in Sacramento.
- All parishes in the Diocese will use both the prayers and readings for the Mass from the Common of the Dedication of a Church on the Anniversary of the Dedication, NOT the readings for the 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time.

Profession of Faith: I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.
