RULES

- Participants must be between the ages of 13-25 and reside within the Sacramento Diocesan geographic region.
- All entries must be family-friendly (no profanity or explicit language, images, etc.) and safe (no risk of injury).
- Time limit of presentation is 1-3 minutes in length.
- Presenters must provide their own props.
- Presenters must attend the required info session/ audition **and** the rehearsal at Good Shepherd Parish Hall.
- **BY SIGNING THIS FORM, YOU ARE PROVIDING CONSENT FOR USE OF AUDIO AND VIDEO FOOTAGE TO BE USED BY THE PARISH OR DIOCESAN PUBLICATION.**

REHEARSAL **Sat. February 28, 2026, 10 a.m.-1 p.m.**

TALENT SHOW **Sat. February 28, 2026, 6-9 p.m.**

- Music performers must bring a **labeled digital version** of your presentation to the auditions
- **Finished (framed)** visual art pieces (completed in the last 3 years), must be brought to the audition on 1/31.
- Poets must bring a **printed version** of your poem to the audition.
- Contest administrators reserve the right to cancel or restrict a particular performance. The decisions made by judges or the show’s management in setting rules or evaluating performances are final and not subject to alteration.
- Winners will be announced at the end of the evening.

- Creativity
- Diction
- Intonation
- Vocal Quality
- Rhythmic Interpretation
- Dynamics
- Song Choice/Song Prep

Instrumental Criteria

- Technical features
- Tone
- Individuality
- Passion
- Confidence

Art Criteria

Electronic or print representation of artwork **must** be submitted at the audition.

Accepted mediums: paint, pastel, clay, mixed-media, fiber art, digital art in print form

Include the year the artwork was created (no more than three years ago).

Include the artist signature.

Size requirements - must not exceed 48" in width or 60" in height. Maximum weight 30 lbs.

Must be able to sit on an easel or table top.

Optional: Artist statement (information/background about the artist, experience with art, awards, information about the piece: media, inspiration, meaning for artist).

- Interpretation and clarity of theme
- Creativity and originality of the depicted theme.
- Quality of artistic composition and overall design based on the theme.
- Overall impression
