



TIRELESS DISCIPLESHIP

The stories we've been hearing these weeks come from the very first chapter of Mark, and they show us the public ministry of Jesus in its infancy. Today's account shows some of the strain or adjustment of his new life of preaching the reign of God, healing the sick, and casting out demons. Notice that after sunset, when darkness ended the workday, people brought the sick and possessed to Jesus. The following day he rose before dawn to get away by himself to pray, but to no avail. Simon Peter and the others don't just look for him, they pursue him, filled with the fervor that his ministry has incited. With the self-sacrificing example he gave until the end of his earthly life, he tells his followers that this is his whole purpose. Through Mark, he is also telling the early church, and he is telling us, that this is our purpose, our vocation: to be tireless in our pursuit of proclaiming the Good News, and in bringing the healing, reconciling touch of Christ to the world.

Important Message

It has been brought to our attention that there was a family begging for money after Masses this past Sunday. They are telling parishioners that they have permission from Father. Please follow these guidelines ALWAYS: The first thing we never want to do is give ANY cash out. Please refer them to SVDP and if they refuse to leave, call Elk Grove PD. We have had to do this before. Father has never given anyone permission to beg for money and never would. Sometimes our parishioners, out of the kindness of their hearts, give money to strangers especially if they have children with them...they know this and that's why they continue to return...referring them to SVDP is the best option we have. SVDP's phone number is 647-1243. Under NO circumstances should any parishioners give cash to anyone.

Flu Season

Flu season is here. Bishop Soto has issued the following directives in order to protect the health and well-being of everyone: the use of the Communion Cup is temporarily suspended; please receive the Body of Christ in the hand; do not shake hands or hold hands during the Our Father. The obligation to attend Mass on Sunday and Holy Days does not apply to those who are sick. If you are sick, out of consideration for others, please stay home. Pray for those who are sick. Thank you for your patience and understanding during this time.




