

Imagine how Saul must have felt when he awoke from his sleep and saw his spear missing from its resting place. FIAT90 / FIAT40 PRAYER JOURNEY FOR WOMEN

Fiat 90 is a 90-day prayer journey of self -discipline, reflection, and building community. Designed for any woman of any age, it gives an opportunity for women to grow closer to God, closer to each other, and closer to the authentic femininity that we are called for alongside the Blessed Mother. FIAT stands for Faith. Integrity, Accountability, Truth. Weekly meetings and daily communication are important in accountability and supporting one another throughout the 90 days. Fiat 90 is typically done leading up to any major Feast Day especially that of the Blessed Mother.

FIAT40 is a shorter version and designed to be done during the 40 days of Lent. We will begin a group on Ash Wednesday, March 2. We encourage all women to join this prayerful journey.
