# FAQ: WHY do I need to complete Parent Service Hours & attend Parent Workshops during my child's Sacramental Preparation?

Sacramental Preparation is a FAMILY journey and as parents, we strive to answer God's call to a life of holiness and service in our relationship with our family. We accomplish this when we share & model the faith to our children.

#### Parent Service Hours to the Parish:

The greatest reward of serving others is how it makes you feel about yourself. That special feeling is God's way of telling you thank you! Thank you for caring! Thank you for making a difference in the world! By doing these service hours in the Parish, you are not only modeling Christian service for your child, you're engaging in your faith community, learning about the various ministries that serve our parish, and helping our parish continue to grow and evangelize!

### How do I find out about Parent Service Hour Opportunities?

Always check the Parish Website (<a href="https://gscceg.org/about/volunteer">https://gscceg.org/about/volunteer</a>) for volunteer opportunities to sign up and volunteer at parish events. Signup links are added throughout the year, but going by past years, these opportunities will slow down in the spring right before the Parent Tracking Sheets are due, so don't delay in completing your Parish Service hours.

As a last resort, if you find that you're short on "time", but not on "treasure", you can exercise the "buyout" option. Every \$20 (Cash OR Gift Card Donation) is equal to 1 Parent Service Hour.

• Acceptable Gift Cards are: Best Buy, Target, & Walmart – we use these to help purchase items for the Religious Education Raffle Baskets and other Religious Education needs each year.

#### **Parent Workshops:**

One of the best gifts you can give your child is the understanding that we are always learning and growing in our faith. Ongoing catechesis is not only possible as an adult, but essential to help us live in an ever deepening relationship with God. The Parent Workshops provide you with continuing catechesis, personal enrichment in your spiritual life and provide practical ways to build up your family in faith.

## How do I sign up to attend the Parent Workshops?

The Parent Workshops are open to all parishioners of Good Shepherd. For the parents with children in Sacramental Preparation, we encourage you to "RSVP" on the signup lists that are linked to the First Holy Eucharist and Confirmation pages on the Parish Website. This will provide an approximate attendance in case we need to prepare handout materials.

The "RSVP" signups are not used as verification of attendance at the workshops. You will still need to sign in upon arrival at the GSCC Religious Education Parent Workshops and get your Parent Tracking Sheet SIGNED/STAMPED after the workshop and at the Diocesan and Parish sponsored events in order to receive credit for attendance.

Please be respectful of the posted workshop times. The sign in sheets at our workshops are picked up 15 minutes after the workshop start time, so anyone arriving late won't be able to sign in to receive credit for that Workshop.
