Do something FUN together: You will each write a brief description of what you did on the Google Form links provided. Nothing makes a relationship stronger than doing something fun together so that you can laugh and just be yourselves. This can be absolutely any fun activity that you and your Candidate want to do together.
Go to Mass together: You will each answer questions 1 & 3 on the Google Form links provided. This can either be done together in-person or if you live in different areas and can't meet in person, pick the same day to go to Mass so that you can discuss the same Gospel and your respective homilies afterward.

Read & Discuss the <u>How Is Your Faith Expressed</u> article by Maura Thompson Hagarty that is linked on the Faith, Discussion & Action page of the parish website.
 On page 3 of the article, Ms. Hagarty reminds us that, "At the end of Mass when the celebrant says, "Go forth" you are being sent out to make Christ's presence known." What do you take away from Mass and how do you make Christ's presence known to the world?
