CANDIDATE, write YOUR responses to the questions below...

1. **The article contrasts “seasonal volunteering” with ongoing service.** Why do you think it can be tempting to serve only at certain times of the year, and how does the Church call us to live a year-round commitment to works of mercy?

2. **Pope Francis spoke about “small daily acts of solidarity” and forming a new mindset.** What might these small acts look like in your everyday life as a student, worker, or family member, and how can they help shape you as a mature Catholic after Confirmation?

3. **The author shares experiences of both authentic service and service that became self-focused.** How can we examine our intentions when serving others, and what helps keep Christ — rather than recognition or convenience — at the center of our actions?

4. **The article highlights the role of family and mentors (like the author's grandmother) in forming a habit of service.** Who has modeled Christian service for you, and how has their example influenced your understanding of what it means to live your faith?

- ☐ **Do something FUN together:** You will complete the Response Questions provided at the end.
Nothing makes a relationship stronger than doing something fun together so that you can laugh and just be yourselves. This can be absolutely any fun activity that you and your Candidate want to do together.

- ☐ **Go to Mass together:** You will complete the Response Questions provided at the end.
This can either be done together in-person or if you live in different areas and can't meet in person, pick the same day to go to Mass so that you can discuss the same Gospel and your respective homilies afterward.

This can either be done together in-person or if you live in different areas and can't physically get together, pick the same organization or similar service activity to do separately (maybe on the same day or week) and discuss your experiences afterward.
